**DAY 01 / AUG 27 MANILA - LISBON**

**DAY 02 / AUG 28 LISBON - FATIMA (D)**

Welcome to Lisbon! Meet your guide and explore Lisbon. Visit the Church and the birthplace of San Antonio de Padua. On to Fatima, one of the main pilgrim sites for Marian devotees. You may join a candlelight procession with other pilgrims at night at the grounds of the Chapel of the Apparitions.

**DAY 03 / AUG 29 FATIMA (B/D)**

Venerate and pray as you explore around the basilica, Casa de Lucia, Casa de Francisco & Jacinta, then proceed to the Chapel of Apparitions – the exact location where the three little shepherd children saw the Blessed Virgin Mary. You may join a candlelight procession with other pilgrims at night.

**DAY 04 / AUG 30 FATIMA - SALAMANCA - AVILA (B/D)**

Proceed to Salamanca and visit Salamanca Cathedral, known for its towering spires and ornate interior. Salamanca is famous for its golden stone buildings. See the handsome arcade of the Plaza Mayor and Puente Romano Bridge. Drive to the walled city of mystic Avila. Hear about the life of St. Teresa, Doctor of the Church and one of the greatest figures in Church history. Eucharistic Celebration.

**DAY 05 / AUG 31 AVILA - MADRID (B/D)**

Breakfast at the hotel. Leave for Madrid. Visit Borbones, they played a significant role in shaping the modernization of Spain. See the Austrias and Isabelinos Quarters to the Moorish Quarters, these quarters are characterized by their unique architectural sites, narrow streets and historical significance. See the Oriente, Espana, Puerta del Sol, Cibeles, Neptuno, Atocha, Plaza de Toros, Parque del Retiro, Puerta de Alcala and Colon. Passing by Royal Palace, the Prado Museum, the memorial Retiro Park and the Bull ring.

**DAY 06 / SEP 01 MADRID - ZARAGOZA - LOURDES (B/D)**

Depart Madrid and proceed to Zaragoza. Visit the Basilica de Nuestra Señora del Pilar also known as Our Lady of the Pillar. The name given to the Blessed Virgin Mary in the context of the traditional belief that Mary, while living in Jerusalem, supernaturally appeared to the Apostle James the Greater in AD 40 while he was preaching in what is now Spain. Overnight in Lourdes.

**DAY 07 / SEP 02 LOURDES (B/D)**

Begin your enlightening visit to Lourdes. Start at Sanctuaries Notre-Dame de Lourdes also known as Sanctuary of Our Lady of Lourdes - a Catholic Marian Shrine dedicated to Our Lady. Pray at Grotte de Massabielle - the cave where the Virgin Mary appeared to St. Bernadette. Also, see Moulin de Boly and a small museum dedicated to St. Bernadette. Prepare for your Eucharistic Celebration in one of the churches. At night, you may join other pilgrims from around the globe for a candlelight procession that usually starts at 9:30 in the evening.

**DAY 08 / SEP 03 LOURDES - PARIS, FRANCE (B/D)**

Depart early on a train heading Paris via TGV. Arrive at Montparnasse station. Free time to explore Paris, the City of Lights at night.

**DAY 09 / SEP 04 PARIS (B/D)**

Take a trip to Zaragoza, the famous residence of the kings of Aragon in the past. Pay a visit to the enormous Basilica of the miraculous Nuestra Senora del Pilar. Make your way to Madrid for the night.

**DAY 10 / SEP 05 PARIS - NEVERS - PARAY LE MONIAL (B/D)**

On to Nevers and visit St. Gildard to see the uncorrupted body of St. Bernadette. Proceed to Cathédrale Saint Cyr et Sainte Julitte, is the seat of the Bishop of Nevers. It is a national monument. The cathedral was designated a basilica in the mid-19th century. City Tour in Paray Le Monial. Visit the Church of the Sacred Heart of Jesus where St. Margarete Alacoque had conversations with our Lord Jesus Christ.

**DAY 11 / SEP 06 PARAY LE MONIAL - TURIN (B/D)**

Today you will visit the Basilica di Maria Ausiliatrice to see the incorrupt body of St John Bosco. Proceed to a city tour of Turin. Overnight at Turin.

**DAY 12 / SEP 07**

**TURIN - PISA - FLORENCE**

**(B/D)**

Proceed to Pisa for a tour at its famous landmark – the Leaning Tower and cathedral. On to Florence for a city tour. Visit to the Baptistery, the Paradise Gates and the Duomo of Florence where you will be enlightened by its beautiful history and miracles. See the Palazzo Vecchio, Town hall of Florence where faith and science join together with breathless revelations.

**DAY 13 / SEP 08**

**FLORENCE - ASSISI**

**(B/D)**

Early morning drive from Florence to Assisi. Enjoy a brief city tour. Visit the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi, a minor basilica dedicated to the saint's birthplace and crypt for his remains. St. Francis was a mystic Italian Catholic friar and the founder of the Franciscans.

**DAY 14 / SEP 09**

**ASSISI - LORETO - LANCIANO - SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO**

**(B/D)**

On to Loreto and visit the Basilica Della Santa Casa or the Sanctuary of the Holy House of Loreto Santuario Della Santa Casa Di Loreto. See the Holy Host being raised in Consecration turned into Real Flesh. Proceed to San Giovanni Rotondo. Visit the Sanctuary of the Lady of Grace and the Shrine of St. Padre Pio and his incorrupt body rests

**DAY 15 / SEP 10**

**SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO - MONTECASSINO - ROME**

**(B/D)**

Visit the beautiful Abbey of Montecassino. A hilltop monastery, known for its multiple battles and destruction during the WWII. On to Rome of the night.

**DAY 16 / SEP 11**

**ROME**

**(B/D)**

Enjoy a full-day visit to St. Peter's Basilica, the largest and the most renowned work of Renaissance Architecture in the world. Next stop, the Vatican Museum – house of over 70,000 works including the masterpiece displays in the Sistine Chapel. Visit St. Paul's Outside the walls. Basilica di Santa Maria Maggiore, a major papal basilica, and St. John Lateran, the oldest and highest-ranking of the four major basilicas in Rome.

Proceed to sightseeing and photo stop at the Colosseum - one of the greatest architectural achievements of the Roman Empire. Roman Forum, is considered the social & and political hub of Ancient Rome.
