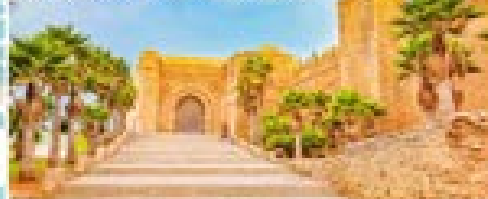
DAY 02

Morocco is a place where multiple religions have co-existed side-by-side that lived in harmony for hundreds of years. Visit the 3rd largest mosque in Morocco. With its minaret towering up 210 meters, the **Hassan II Mosque** blends Islamic architecture with Moroccan elements, Moorish influences with urban design passing at the **United Nations Square**. Walk through alleyways to reach the medina, where you can browse alongside locals going about their day-to-day business selling traditional souvenirs and clothing to both locals and tourists. See one of the most important Palace in Casablanca – **Palais Royal de Casablanca** - the official residence of His Majesty King Mohammed VI of Morocco and his Family A masterpiece of Islamic architecture surrounded by picturesque orange groves. Immerse yourself in the 1942 classic Hollywood movie Casablanca shooting location "Rick's Cafe", starring Humprey Bogart and Ingrid Bergman, considered as one of the greatest film of all time.

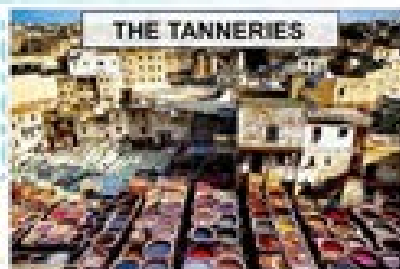
Kasbah Des Oudaias



Drive to **Rabat**, the capital of Morocco and enjoy this magnificent city declared as the **UNESCO World Heritage sites** visiting the most prominent places, such as the **Mausoleum of Mohammed V** and the **Hassan Tower** of the twelfth century. Visit the **Kasbah Des Oudaias**, home to many Andalusian immigrants, Arab tribes, and some of the most powerful sultans of Morocco. It is a charming medieval fortress district that was the first settlement in Rabat. See Morocco's trademark blue-and white houses with their colorful flower pots and hand-painted gates. Back to Casablanca for the night.

MARRAKECH
Explore Marrakech and discover the places that captured the heart of world-famous fashion designer, "Yves Saint Laurent", *The Majorelle*. Yves Saint Laurent's first visit to Marrakech marked the start of a love affair. Captivated by the city's colors and clamor, he promptly purchased a home in the heart of the Medina, which served as a refuge from the mania of Paris. Walk in the footsteps of this world-famous designer, and discover the city through his eyes. Photo stop at **Palais de la Bahia**, a 160-room Palace took 15 years to build, and it provides an opportunity to admire and learn about Moroccan architecture Soaring over Marrakech and the meeting point in the heart of the city, the **Koutoubia Mosque**, built during the 12th century at 70m high, the minaret remains the highest structure and the largest mosque in Marrakech. Next is a visit to **Souk and Medina**. What makes the souks or markets in Marrakesh fabulous is the presence of exotic items like babouches, lanterns, tagines, carpets, leather goods in addition to the local fruits, vegetables and spices.

See one of the oldest functioning religious colleges in the country at **Bou Inania Medersa**, a historic institution known for its elaborate architecture. The building stands as one of the best-preserved examples of Marinid architecture, boasting latticed woodwork and geometric tile decorations.

Fez is known for quality leather goods. Visit **the tanneries**, most of the leatherworkers have a terrace allowing them to observe the wells of dried-earth brick and tiles where the tanning and hanging of the skins are carried out. It is a spectacle of sunny colours for the delight of the eyes!

See and admire the seven imposing front gates of **The Royal Palace**, the official residence of the King of Morocco. Surrounded by fine tilework and carved cedar wood. They are masterpieces of modern craft work. No one visits Fez without passing by **Bab Boujloud**, a glittering mosaic tiles and grand archway leading to the main entrance into the medina, the famed "blue gate".
