**THE King's ROUTE**

**DAY 01 / SEP 09**

**DEPART MANILA**

**DAY 02 / SEP 10**

**ARRIVE LONDON**

**(D)**

Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel in London. Rest for the night.

**DAY 03 / SEP 11**

**LONDON - STONEHENGE - BATH - CARDIFF, WALES (B/D)**

Prepare for a full day tour. Visit **Stonehenge** (UNESCO World Heritage site) – a prehistoric megalithic structure on Salisbury Plain. It is the most architecturally sophisticated and only surviving linteled stone circle in the world. Next, visit to the **Roman Bath** museum – one of the great religious spas of the ancient world! Proceed to Cardiff and stay overnight.

**DAY 04 / SEP 12**

**CARDIFF - ROSSLARE - WATERFORD, IRELAND (B/D)**

Start your day by visiting the **Cardiff Castle**, a medieval castle and Victorian Gothic revival mansion built in the late 11th century. Depart Fishguard to Rosslare and cross the Irish Sea. Arrive Ireland, then proceed to Waterford.

**DAY 05 / SEP 13**

**WATERFORD - CORK - BLARNEY - KILLARNEY (B/D)**

Have a sparkly day as you visit the **House of Waterford Crystal** – the factory is the beating heart of Waterford's crystal manufacture and is where the most intricate, authentic, and masterful crystal pieces come to life. Drive to Cork, then proceed to Blarney for a visit to the famous **Blarney Castle** – a medieval stronghold. Make sure to kiss the '*Blarney Stone*'! Overnight in Killarney.

**DAY 06 / SEP 14**

**KILLARNEY - KNOCK - CLIFFS OF MOHER - GALWAY (B/D)**

Depart for Knock to visit the **Apparition Church**, where "Our Lady was wearing a large, brilliant crown and clothed in white garments, along with Saint Joseph and Saint John the Evangelist"...

Visit the **Cliffs of Moher** (UNESCO World heritage site), with its towering heights, crashing waves and ageless legends. This was also the shooting location of Harry Potter and the Half Blood Prince! Take a photo at O'Brien's Tower, the highest point of the cliff. Drive to Galway and stay for the night.

**DAY 07 / SEP 15**

**GALWAY - DUBLIN**

**(B/D)**

Enjoy half-day touring around Galway, visit the iconic **Galway Cathedral** built in 1958 to commemorate Our Lady and St. Nicholas. Then, proceed to Dublin. See O'Connell Street and the Georgian Squares. Tonight, experience an **Irish Dinner Show** – a Celtic Night!

**DAY 08 / SEP 16**

**DUBLIN - BELFAST**

**(B/D)**

Explore the city of **Dublin** – the capital and the largest city of Ireland. Visit **St. Patrick's Cathedral**, where St. Patrick baptized the pagans to Christianity in the 5th Century. Cheers for the drinkers! Now, you get to visit the **Jameson Distillery**, the world's leading distillery tours and a monument to Irish Whiskey! Continue your sightseeing to Trinity College, General Post Office, and Dublin Castle for photo stops. Drive to Belfast, capital of Northern Ireland.

**DAY 09 / SEP 17**

**BELFAST - GIANT'S CAUSEWAY - BELFAST**

**(B/D)**

Visit and be amazed at the **Giant's Causeway**, composed of 40,000 interlocking basalt column, the result of an ancient volcanic fissure eruption. Continue your sightseeing at St. Anne's Cathedral, Belfast Castle, City hall and George Market for photo stops.

**DAY 10 / SEP 18**

**BELFAST - GLASGOW - EDINBURGH, SCOTLAND**

**(B/D)**

Go to pier and aboard the ferry going to **Scotland**! Drive to **Glasgow**, Scotland's largest city and visit **The Tall Ship** at **Glasgow harbor**. Then, proceed to Edinburgh and stay for the night.

**DAY 11 / SEP 19**

**EDINBURGH**

**(B/D)**

Take a tour at the **Edinburgh Castle** and admire Scotland's Crown Jewels – one of the oldest fortified places in Europe. There has been a royal castle on the rock since at least the reign of Malcolm III in the 11th century. Also, visit **The Scotch Whisky Experience**. Photo stop at the Palace of Holyrood.

**DAY 12 / SEP 20**

**EDINBURGH - YORK - LIVERPOOL**

**(B/D)**

Depart for York and visit **York Minster** (Cathedral and Metropolitan Church of Saint Peter in York) – one of the world's most magnificent cathedral and the center of Christianity in the north of England. Drive to **Liverpool**, the hometown of The Beatles, which you will visit as part of the tour. Overnight in Liverpool.

**DAY 13 / SEP 21 LIVERPOOL - STRATFORD UPON AVON - WOODSTOCK - OXFORD (B/D)**

Depart for Stratford Upon Avon – a medieval market town in England’s West Midlands and the birthplace of William Shakespeare. Visit his childhood home and discover how the extraordinary playwright continues to shape our lives today. After that, drive to Woodstock for a royal visit to **Blenheim Palace** (UNESCO World heritage site). The palace is named after the 1704 Battle of Blenheim and a reward to John Churchill, 1st Duke of Marlborough for his military triumphs. Overnight in Oxford.

**DAY 14 / SEP 22 OXFORD - WINDSOR - LONDON (B/D)**

Welcome to **Oxford**! Home to the University of Oxford, the oldest university in the English-speaking world – as early as 1096! Take a tour inside **Trinity College**, one of the constituent colleges of the University which used to be a home to Benedictine monks. Next stop, feel like royalty and take a tour around the magnificent **Windsor Castle**! It is the oldest and largest occupied castle in the world. Founded by William the Conqueror in the 11th century, it has been the family home of British kings and queens for almost 1,000 years. Depart for London.

**DAY 15 / SEP 23 LONDON (B/D)**

Take a tour around **London**, the capital of England and the United Kingdom. Begin your exploration by visiting the **Tower of London** – built as a secure fortress and a symbol of royal power, see inside the precious Crown Jewels!. Continue your sightseeing to *St. Paul Cathedral, House of Parliament, White Hall, Hyde Park and Downing Street* for photo op.

Visit the **Westminster Abbey**, formally called the Collegiate Church of Saint Peter. It has been the setting for every coronation since 1066 including sixteen royal weddings! Continue your sightseeing to *Big Ben, Outside of Buckingham Palace, Trafalgar Square and The Harrods* for photo ops.

At night, take the opportunity to watch the Award-Winning West End Musicals like *Les Miserables, Mamma Mia, Phantom of the Opera, The Lion King* and many more!

The day is at leisure for you to shop at London’s iconic stores like Harrods, Selfridges, Marks & Spencer and many more! Meet your transfer in the afternoon for your flight back to Manila.
